SAFETY ON THE COURSE – DANGEROUS SITUATION – **LIGHTNING**

SUSPENSION OF PLAY FOR LIGHTNING WILL BE SIGNALLED BY A PROLONGED BLAST ON A KLAXON

MANDATORY POLICY ON THE COURSE CLOSURE FOR LIGHTNING & FOG

IF PLAYERS ARE BETWEEN THE PLAY OF TWO HOLES THEY **SHALL NOT** RESUME PLAY UNTIL A RESUMPTION OF PLAY HAS BEEN ORDERED.

PLAYERS IN THE PROCESS OF PLAYING A HOLE **SHALL DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY** MARKING THEIR BALLS AND **SHALL NOT** RESUME PLAY UNTIL A RESUMPTION OF PLAY HAS BEEN ORDERED.

EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO ENSURE THE KLAXON IS SOUNDED ALLOWING SUFFICIENT TIME FOR EVERYONE TO EVACUATE THE COURSE. WHEN ON DUTY THE COURSE MARSHALLS WILL BE DISPATCHED TO ENSURE PEOPLE HEARD THE KLAXON AND ARE EVACUATING THE COURSE.

IF THERE IS INSUFFICIENT TIME TO EVACUATE THE COURSE WHEN THE KLAXON IS SOUNDED PLEASE ENSURE THAT: -

YOU STAND AWAY FROM YOUR CLUBS AND TROLLEY

YOU DO NOT SHELTER UNDER TREES OR ON HIGH GROUND

YOU DO NOT EVACUATE THE COURSE BY WALKING UNDER TREES

DO NOT USE A MOBILE PHONE

KEEP AS LOW AS POSSIBLE AND IF NECESSARY CROUCH DOWN IN THE NEAREST BUNKER WHICH IS NOT FLOODED, OR SEEK LOWER GROUND

AVOID STANDING IN WATER

DO NOT PUT UP AN UMBRELLA UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES

RESUMPTION OF PLAY WILL BE SIGNALLED BY TWO BLASTS OF THE KLAXON.

PLAYERS WHO ARE AT THE CLUBHOUSE WILL BE GIVEN SUFFICIENT TIME TO REACH THEIR POSITION ON THE COURSE BEFORE THE KLAXON IS SOUNDED FOR THE RESUMPTION OF PLAY.

IN THE EVENT OF FOG, PLAY MUST NOT COMMENCE UNTIL THE TREE (HOLM OAK) ON THE LEFTHAND SIDE OF THE 10TH FAIRWAY IS CLEARLY VISABLE FROM WHITE TEE PLATES ON THE 10TH TEE.
